The Web Developer will provide ongoing technical support for the content team, maintain and further improve the Portal and its performance, and work on the development of new features.

- Proven experience with multiple javascript libraries and frameworks;
- Ability to maintain a search engine;
- Familiarity with GIT;
- Good English language skills; knowledge of German would be an asset.
