RCC Society of Fellows Public Outreach Grant

Grant Description

The Public Outreach grant supports a project created by an RCC Society of Fellows member or members that engages a general public audience in the field of environmental humanities. Projects might include, for example, a public lecture, a museum or art exhibition, or a podcast. All types of endeavors geared toward the public will be considered.

The total annual funding for the Public Outreach grant is 3,000 euros. With this limited budget, we hope to support two or more projects. Our goal is to distribute the funds to as many projects as possible while still providing meaningful support.

Criteria

Applications will be evaluated on:

- Public outreach potential
 - O How strong is the project's public outreach component? Can it effectively engage the public with the RCC, RCC alumni, and the environmental humanities?
- Necessity and innovation
 - O Does this project fill a particular gap? Will it offer something not already available to the public? Does it offer new approaches to a particular issue?
- Feasibility
 - o Can the project be completed?

Application Procedure

To apply, please submit the following three items together as one single PDF:

- 1) A one-page, single-spaced letter of application that describes your proposed project. In this letter, please include the following:
 - a. A description of the project, its purpose and importance, and why the applicant or applicants is/are well suited for this project.
 - b. A projected timeline, including where the project is in the process and when the project should be completed
- 2) Budget: A one-page breakdown of costs to be incurred, including which specific part of the project you want the RCC grant to support. If you have applied for or received other sources of funding for this project (i.e. this RCC grant would constitute partial funding for your project), please indicate that here.
- 3) A two-page CV for each participant

Grant Follow-Up Requirements

Within four weeks of completing the project or within six months of receiving the grant, please submit a one- or two-page report about your activities and its outcomes and a separate one-paragraph summary that we can include in the RCC Society of Fellows newsletter. We also plan to post the report on "Seeing the Woods," the RCC blog. If you are able to, please include photographs with your report.
