The Sahrawi people have been resisting Morocco's illegal occupation for 50 years – politically, diplomatically, and militarily. While European corporations like Siemens Energy profit from resource exploitation, the European Court of Justice confirmed in 2024 that EU-Morocco agreements violate international law.

Focus: Feminist resistance. Sahrawi women not only shape their society but have carved out unique spaces of liberation in their struggle.

Featuring Najla Mohamed-Lamin, born in Sahrawi refugee camps and an internationally recognized activist for her people's rights. In 2023, the BBC named her one of the 100 most important women.

The event will begin with a screening of the 26-minute documentary "Insumisas - Women in Struggle in Western Sahara", highlighting the leading role of Sahrawi women.
