»People – Nature – Future« presents the internationally awarded works by the Scandinavian artist duo Karoline Hjorth and Riitta Ikonen.

In their remarkable art project »Eyes as Big as Plates«, which has been ongoing since 2011, the artists explore the relationship between people and nature. To this end, they have travelled the world and portrayed people in a wide variety of landscapes. The portrait series shows individuals wrapped in artistic sculptures made from elements of the environment. Nature serves both as content and context here. With playful ease, symbiotic narratives and new aesthetic worlds emerge, conveying a strong message: We are nature!

This exhibition was curated and organised by Symbio(s)cene and realised in collaboration with the Rachel Carson Center for Environment and Society. Symbio(s)cene is a non-profit organisation that aims to contribute to new, sustainable worldviews and to promote thinking beyond the Anthropocene. Demonstrating new ways of seeing is an important key to the change that is so urgently needed. Symbio(s)cene advocates a holistic approach that bridges the sciences and the arts in order to give space to both the cognitive and the emotional dimension of knowledge and thus to open up new perspectives for a sustainable humannature relationship and a future worth living.
